Sanitary Sewer Collection Fees Increase for 2010:

The District has a contract with the City of Littleton to treat the sanitary sewer from the District. In 2009, the City of Littleton increased the sewer treatment cost to the District by 6% and the District increased the residential sewer fees by 7%.

In 2010, the City of Littleton will increase sewer treatment costs by 9% and the District will increase sanitary sewer collection fees by 9%. The 2010 residential bi-monthly sanitary sewer charge will be \$52.68; that's an increase of \$4.35 on your bi-monthly sewer bill.

Sewer fees collected by the District cover the cost of paying for sewer treatment. The fees collected also cover the operation and maintenance expenses associated with the District's own sanitary sewer collection system including repairs, capital improvements, and administration. The District does not receive any tax revenue from its customers and solely operates from water and sewer fees.
